I am extremely excited with the range of programs for all age groups offered through Greendale Park & Recreation for the fall. Whether it's day trips, workshops around health & wellness, learning about new games, or participating in the fall recreation leagues or fitness programs, Greendale Park & Rec has much to offer our adults in the community. For our youth, it offers a full slate of opportunities this fall from aquatic and after-school sports programs to high interest activities like theater, cooking, and visual arts.

Greendale Park & Rec continues to focus on service, providing new programming based on the feedback from the community survey that was done in January 2017. The survey revealed a need to offer youth

programming immediately following the school day at the elementary schools with a focus on athletic activities or expanded opportunities in computer programming, coding, robotics, and service projects. As part of VISION 2020, Park & Rec serves a critical role in the expansion of youth engagement in the community through before and after school enrichment opportunities. Community members will see this commitment to the strategic work of the district with the range of new youth offerings this fall.

As part of providing exceptional service to the community, I also want to make community members aware of a shift that will occur with the winter registration. All registrations for Park & Recreation activities will be done online. While Park & Recreation has offered an online process in the past, all participants will be required to use the online system for registration for the winter programming. This shift is

happening to improve customer service through a more effective and efficient registration system. While the department will no longer take hard copies from registrants for winter registration, the team will offer kiosks and assistance at the Community Learning Center for those community members who may not be familiar or comfortable with the technology. I look forward to this shift to better serve the community.
