

Easy Ways to Register

Priority

Come and draw a number on Wednesday, May 10th (8:00 a.m. - 6:30 p.m.) to receive priority registration on the night of Thursday, May 11th.

or

In-Person

Residents may drop off forms and payment beginning Monday, May 15th during office hours.

Class registrations begin Tuesday May 16th. Remember to set-up your household account at least 3 business days prior.

General Information

Registrations are required prior to class attendance. Registrations may be accepted after classes begin if space is available; however, class fees are not prorated. **No confirmations returned without submitting a self-addressed, stamped envelope.**

Forms of payment include cash, checks, money orders, MasterCard, VISA, or Discover Card for class registrations. All payments must be received at the time of the class registration. Returned checks are subject to a \$36.00 service charge.

Open Enrollment Families attending Greendale School District Schools (public schools) for the 2017-2018 school year may first register on Thursday, May 11th at 7:40 p.m. (after our residents have completed their registration) or starting on Monday, May 15th, or phone (begins May 16th). No need to draw a number for Thursday, May 11th. Follow resident fee schedule.

The fee for non-residents in all recreation programs will be the fee listed with each program. Non-residents may register for classes beginning Tuesday, May 16th either in-person, phone-in, mail, or online.

Class transfers may be made subject to class availability and AT LEAST 3 BUSINESS DAYS, (or 6 BUSINESS DAYS for arts and crafts, cooking/food classes, deadlines noted on getaways/outings, and Mad Science/Bricks 4 Kidz classes) prior to the starting date of the class. A \$5.00 processing fee will apply.

Anyone registering less than 3 business days prior to the starting date of any class may be assessed a \$7.50 **late registration fee**, per class. Registrations may be submitted by telephone, mail or in-person within the aforementioned time frame.

CANCELLATION POLICY

1. User fees cover the costs to offer these programs. When you sign-up for a class, we depend on your enrollment for a successful class. Please plan your schedule carefully.
2. If you must cancel from a class, call (414) 423-2790 at least 3 business days (6 business days for arts and crafts, Mad Science/Bricks 4 Kidz, deadlines noted on getaways/outings, and cooking/food classes) before the class is scheduled to start; otherwise no refunds granted. Choose from two options:
A) transfer to another class within this semester of classes, or B) receive a refund. Either way, your white receipt must be submitted to the Park and Recreation Office. A \$5.00 processing fee will apply.
3. Please allow 10 to 14 business days for refunds.

Please set up your household account, if you intend to use our online registration process, at least 7 business days before you plan to register. Please go to the website below and click on "Create Account." Then fill out the information and we will then assign your household an ID number and a pin number and you will be ready to register for classes online! Note: if, when trying to set up a household account, you get an error message about a duplicate household, please call or stop by the office to verify your information and get your online household information for future use.

- ✓ Draw a number out of our box (numbers 1-500) at the Park and Recreation Office on Wednesday, May 10th between 8:00 a.m. and 6:30 p.m. for registration on Thursday, May 11th.
- ✓ Bring your drawn number to registration on Thursday, May 11th beginning at the time indicated on the sheet you are given when you draw your number. It will be sometime between 6:15 p.m. and 7:30 p.m.
- ✓ Registration will be held in the Community Learning Center (5647 Broad Street) lower level.
- ✓ If you cannot make it Wednesday, May 10th to draw your number, you may still register on Thursday, May 11th. You must come at 7:30 p.m. and obtain a number from the registration clerk in the Community Learning Center.
- ✓ Registration closes by 7:50 p.m. on Thursday, May 11th. All number sheets issued are void after 7:50 p.m.
- ✓ Persons may register for their immediate family members only who reside at the same address. Neighbors may not register for neighbors.
