


**NEW!** **Hamburger Fest 2017**

## Memorial Tree & Bench Program

To request either a bench or tree, please submit a written request with the appropriate payment to the Greendale Park and Recreation Department. Visit the Park and Recreation Department's website at [gpr.greendale.k12.wi.us/parks.html](http://gpr.greendale.k12.wi.us/parks.html) to review the information, fees and guidelines for requesting a memorial.

There are two options for the memorial bench that have been pre-approved for durability and ease of maintenance by the Greendale DPW and certain species of trees designated for parts of the Village. The DPW will take care of installation of the bench or planting of the tree. For an additional fee an engraved plate can be installed on the bench to further add to the memorial.
