Dear Community Members,

Greendale Park & Recreation continues to provide exceptional programming to all age groups in our community. Recent satisfaction surveys indicate that 93% of respondents are satisfied or extremely satisfied with the programs in which they participated.

As we move into the fall season, Park & Rec will once again target increased opportunities for our youth through after-school programming. While we saw a tremendous increase in students taking advantage of these programs last year (with close to 40% of elementary age students participating), our goal is to see these numbers continue to climb. We hope you take advantage of the different opportunities provided.

As the District continues to improve facilities according to the referendum work promised, we ask community members to be adaptable and flexible. Renovations are happening in all of our schools, including the spaces typically used by Park & Rec programs. While there may be some temporary shifts in the times and locations of some events and activities right now, the goal is to have all renovations and construction completed by the beginning of the 2020-2021 school year. So we expect this will be the only year impacted by the facility improvement work.

Greendale Park & Rec's commitment to exceptional service includes utilizing effective communication tools. Its online registration process is one tool that has made sign up easier and more efficient. In the

recent registration period, 54% of participants used this method to sign up for programs. Be sure to watch for the frequent social media posts from Park & Rec staff that highlight classes and activities offered. The social media presence also gives the department opportunities to promote programs and celebrate participants.
