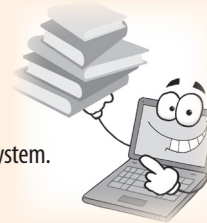

Google and You!

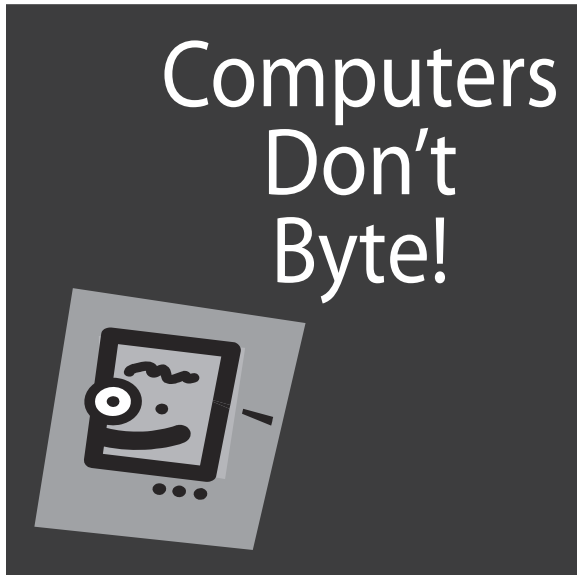

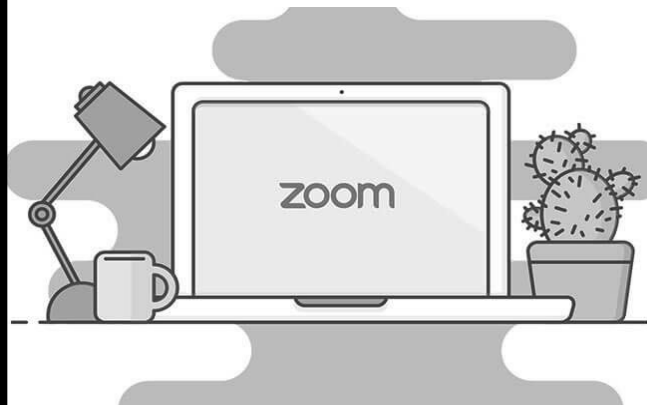
