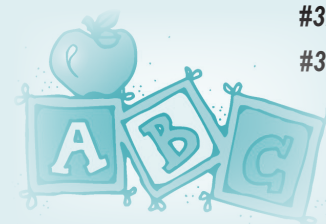

American Red Cross Babysitters Training with Pediatric CPR and First Aid (Blended Learning)

ages 11 through 13

Learn about the job of a babysitter in this course from effective supervision of children and infants; to choosing safe, age appropriate games and toys; to performing basic child-care skills such as diapering, feeding, and dressing. Discuss how to find and interview for a babysitting job and how to communicate effectively with parents. This is a blended learning course including an online portion followed by an instructor-led classroom skill session. After completing the online classwork at home, you will practice and polish your CPR and First Aid skills, and learn to prevent emergencies by identifying safety hazards and how to provide care for common injuries such as burns, cuts, and bee stings, should they occur.

The online portion of class must be completed **PRIOR** to attending the in-class portion and must be taken on a PC or tablet with a high-speed Internet connection. Allow approximately 2 - 3 hours to complete the online portion. **Each participant must have their own, individual email to create their online account.** This email used cannot already be in use with the American Red Cross by another individual. Students must bring proof of completion of the online program to the first day of class in order to attend the hands-on session. An email including the online class link will be sent a few weeks prior to the first day of class.

Upon successful completion of the course, participants will receive the American Red Cross Babysitters Training (no expiration) and Pediatric CPR with First Aid (expires in 2 years) certifications.
