## 4K Readiness Preschool for 3/4 Year Olds

Bloom 'N Grow, starting its 23rd year as an early educational learning program, is dedicated to making each child's first learning experience a positive one. Our program provides a controlled, warm, secure and happy environment. The Bloom 'N Grow preschool program implements the Wisconsin Model Early Learning Standards to provide a positive first school experience for your child. Through extended choices in their learning experience, students will be able to develop a healthy self-image, self-esteem, self-control and a positive attitude toward future school years.

- Classes begin September 3, 2019 and run through May 14, 2020.
- Any child who turns 3 (resident or non-resident), and is toilet-trained, by September 1st may be enrolled.
- All activities are age appropriate, allowing each child to develop at his/her own ability.
- Children to staff ratio is 8:1. Lesson planning and direct instruction is implemented through a collaborative approach with the Greendale School District Early Childhood Staff.
- The Bloom 'N Grow classroom is located at the Greendale Middle School in the Student Activity Center (6800 Schoolway).
