League Information

- First team listed is home team and will sit on 1st base side.
- No infield practice at any time. No batting practice until games are completed on both fields.
- **Rainout number is (414)423-2803 after 3:30 p.m.** If there is no reference to softball games, games are ON. Only if games are being cancelled will the recording reference softball game status.
- **Make-up Games** will be scheduled as doubleheaders throughout the season.
- No drinking of fermented or alcoholic beverages at the complex or in the parking lot.
- Drinking fountains may not be operational at Community Center Park this summer.

Guidelines to help prevent the spread of COVID-19:

- Players/spectators experiencing symptoms or are sick are not allowed to play or attend and should stay home until they are no longer experiencing symptoms.
- Spectators and players are not required to wear masks while on the field (but highly encouraged); however, they are required in the dugout areas when not socially distanced at 6'.
- Try to limit the number of spectators that come to watch games.
- Conduct pregame warmups in areas where the players can spread out.
- Have players utilize their own equipment (gloves and bats) and use batting gloves as much as possible.
- Spread out personal belongings to avoid close contact and bring your own filled water bottle.
- Follow social distancing guidelines as best as possible (6 feet), especially when in dugouts. Teams may need to spread out down the foul line or behind the dugout depending on the number of players.
- We highly recommend spectators and players bring their own chairs and blankets to spread out, instead of using the bleachers (as they are not cleaned/sanitized every day).
- Shared equipment should be disinfected regularly.
- Players are encouraged to bring their own personal wipes or sanitizer to use during games.
- Avoid handshakes/high fives, but good sportsmanship is encouraged, etc.
