Available ONLY for students registered for in-person instruction through Greendale School District.

PROGRAM FEES

Initial Registration Fees:

\$35.00 per child

\$65.00 per family (when registering at the same time)

(This registration fee for the entire school year must be paid by everyone using before/after/digital child care.)

A minimum of one (1) day per week is required, with a monthly schedule due by the 21st of each preceding month (or the date listed on the monthly calendar). Add-on dates, once calendar is submitted, \$2.50 per date (in addition to required fees) if space available.

*I need assistance with costs to access child care for my student. Families that qualify for reduced (or no) school fees based on income qualifications will also be eligible for reduced fees for ONLY the Wednesday Digital Day Child Care. The federal Free & Reduced Meal Program provides the guidance on income eligibility. That application can be completed online.
